Three Clicks Wines 2014 Napa Valley Petite Sirah

320 cases produced

The 2014 Petite Sirah has a floral, blackberry and boysenberry nose with licorice, crushed rock and graphite. The wine has terrific intensity, magnificent concentration and a long, rich finish. About 40% new oak was used in its upbringing and the wine is set for 25-35 years of aging potential.

Three Clicks Wines 2015 Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc

600 cases produced

The delicious 2015 Sauvignon Blanc from Napa is a 600-case cuvée with 25% of the Musqué clone of Sauvignon represented, so one sees honeysuckle and more tropical and exotic fruits along with the telltale grapefruit and melony notes. This medium-bodied, nicely textured, dry Sauvignon has real exuberance and a flamboyant personality – and I adored it for that. Drink it over the next several years.

Three Clicks Wines 2015 Rockpile Grenache Blanc

180 cases produced

Rarely do you see much Grenache Blanc in California, but the 2015 Grenache Blanc Rockpile from Sonoma is outstanding. This is a grape generally used for blending, but here the notes of white flowers, quince and delicate citrus all combine to provide a medium-bodied, fresh, lively wine that I doubt saw any new oak, as it certainly doesn't taste like it. This is a pretty, yet full-flavored wine to drink over the next several years.

Three Clicks Wines 2015 Napa Valley Grenache

110 cases produced

Devlin has produced a delicious 2015 Grenache Frediani from Calistoga. It has the classic dark ruby color, a big, sweet abundant nose of kirsch liqueur, lavender and a touch of earth and pepper. It is dense, wonderfully fruity, medium to full-bodied and surprisingly only 14.8% natural alcohol, which is about the lowest you see for a ripe Grenache. Drink it over the next 4-5 years.
